Even so, the turnout was so high that some even had to use the overflow area – including, once again, some fantastic "non-Calibras."

What should you bring? Ideally, your Calibra (not required for participation!) or another classic car over 30 years old (which can then be parked in the back courtyard), plenty of good cheer, and the usual respect for people and vehicles. As always, this is planned as a one-day event (with a wrap-up on Sunday for those who traveled a long way) to nurture old friendships, meet new faces, and, of course, engage in plenty of car talk. And for those who don't fancy sitting still for long: The "Calibra-Stall" is once again hosting an active wrenching session! The workshops have become legendary – a lift, pit, and tools are available for everyone who enjoys getting their hands dirty.

Note: I'm always overwhelmed by the wonderful gifts you bring – thank you for your kindness! If you'd like to do something extra for me: Every euro in our "coffee fund" helps me make the farm meet even better each year. I invest not only in new decorations but also in many small details that make the event even more enjoyable for you. Come and be surprised by what's new this time! The event remains free of charge!

**Overnight Stay & Camping:** For those who would like to stay overnight: You are welcome to camp or set up your temporary camping spot with us. If you prefer a bit more warmth, there is plenty of space in the Calibra barn for igloo tents or air mattresses. If you would rather have a solid roof over your head, you will find a short list of affordable guesthouses nearby at the end of this text.

**Food & Barbecue:**

- **Drinks:** As usual, plenty of chilled complimentary drinks will be available. Coffee cups are provided, but you are of course welcome to bring your own reusable cups.
- **Food:** The grills are hot! I will provide the charcoal and a large gas grill – please bring your own food (meat, sausages, etc.). If you don't feel like bbq: There is a bistro with a wide selection just 300m away that even delivers directly to the farm.
- **Dishes:** It's best to bring your own cutlery and plates. To keep the place clean for everyone, please remember to clear away leftovers and used dishes immediately. (We have disposable placemats available in case of emergency.)
- **Snacks/Merchandise:** Our popular "Brühpuller" (hot dogs) will be back, coffee and cake will be available at cost. So please bring some small change – especially if you want to snag one of the coveted mugs, banners, Calibra cushions, flags, or other exclusive items! There are lots of new things to take home, so come and see!

**Evening Program & Atmosphere:** As soon as dusk falls, we'll fire up the trusty old drum. The best conversations often start here, lasting late into the night! Please keep the volume down so that the neighbors remain friends of the gathering. Alternatively, the heated Calibra barn offers a weatherproof spot for a cozy evening with friends.

**Breakfast together:** On Sunday morning, we'll wind down the meeting in a relaxed atmosphere. From around 8:00 a.m., all overnight guests can enjoy a free breakfast together in or outside the Calibra stable – with fresh rolls, coffee, and everything else you'd expect.
